




## initiativitis













- Place or people (capital or revenue)
- One tends to prioritise things like environment and fear of crime
- The other prioritises jobs and health
- One can achieve measurable improvements in a few years
- The other does not even begin to show reliable effects for at least 6/7 years
- Partnership working essential **but** not easy





- A huge amount of evidence about what works and what does not work
- 18 Policy Action Teams
- Variety of delivery `mechanisms'
- Centres of Excellence

  - Great British Refurb






## ...since the election

- Local Enterprise Partnerships


















## **`**Rebalancing the economy'

## Localism...

Local communities will be given:

- "control over legislation and planning decision"
- powers to save local services and facilities threatened with closure
- the right to take over 'state-run' services
- The right to provide homes for local people through new local housing trusts





## **Beyond the Big Society...**

- A good fit with community empowerment
- Carbon reduction driving thinking about the built environment, infrastructure, energy, food, manufacturing and public service delivery
