UK still “has a heavily centralised and over-specialised economy, lacks economic diversity, has poor infrastructure and is not resilient to global economic change” - CLES

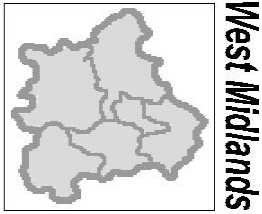

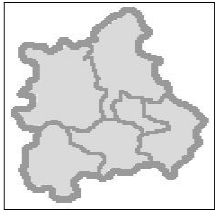
