# What we did

- Local (unemployed) people for local jobs (social care)
- Recruited differently
  - Joint selection & interview
  - Skills scan not paper based
  - Commitment (employer and trainee)
- VERY SHORT TIMESCALE



# Result

- 16 started 16 finished 16 went into jobs guaranteed for 6/12
- At end of 6/12
  - 8 went into permanent jobs 1 in NHS
  - 7 onto Council 'bank'
  - 1 failed enhanced CRB



## Some Critical Outcomes

- Initially, unrealistic expectations of work
- 69% thought wouldn't have got job via traditional route
- 95% satisfied with interview process
- Self-confidence increased with the programme - 85% by 2<sup>nd</sup> month of job
- 90% financially better off



## Health Gains

- 77% personal life better
- 85% happier than before programme
- 70% reported +ive effect on family
- Mental and physical well-being
- Profoundly +ive effect on outlook on life
- Growing social and financial independence



#### Recruitment a key to success

- Wouldn't have made it through traditional recruitment avenues
- Managers agree
- Must mean that excellent, potential employees not getting fair crack of the whip



## **Organisational Considerations**

- Challenges structures, processes and people
- Less bureaucratic recruitment can generate bureaucratic resistance
- Need to sell concept to the whole food chain
- Sustainability



## What makes LWW different?

- Not pay
- Guaranteed work
- Career/skills escalator
- Worthwhile work
- People feel valued
- Releases latent talent and skills
- Gives people vision



#### Lessons for Government

- Benefit changes are only one option
- Linking learning and earning is likely to prove more successful and longer lasting
- Public sector has a duty to lead by example Corporate Social Responsibility embedded
- Public sector has to work in concert



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
