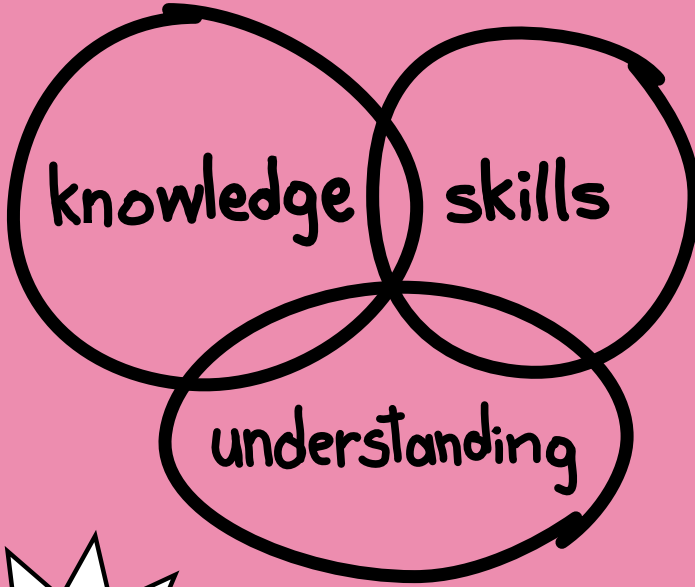




Training Courses 2011

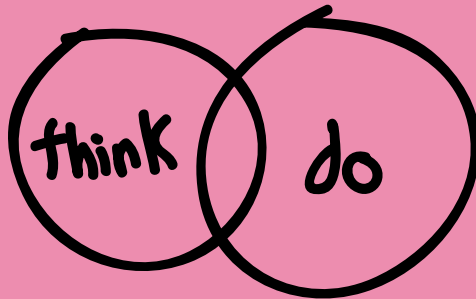
